



## *Rescue My Ride*

### **Program Description and Rules**

#### **What is the goal of Rescue My Ride?**

To provide free auto body repair for individuals, families or nonprofit service organizations who are in challenging situations. In today's difficult economy, many people are unable to make needed auto body repairs due to lack of adequate insurance coverage or higher deductibles. In some cases, these unattended repairs can lead to serious safety issues. Sometimes, simply repairing minor damage from fender benders such as dents and scratches can restore pride of ownership or perhaps provide a positive lift to an individual or family down on their luck.

#### **How did this program get started?**

We received a letter from a customer on behalf of a friend who was battling leukemia and couldn't afford to fix his car. Giving back to the communities we serve is part of our company culture and mission. Our team not only wanted to help this young man, but wanted to take this one step further and help more people in need on a regular basis.

#### **Who is eligible?**

Individuals, families, or tax-exempt nonprofit organizations. Individuals must be 21 years or older and legal U.S. resident. Nominees will not be eligible if they are uninsurable for any of the following reasons:

- Prior DUI Conviction
- Reckless Driving Charge in the last 5 years
- Currently driving an uninsured vehicle

#### **How will recipients be selected?**

Our review committee includes 911 Collision Centers representatives and selected community members. The committee will review nominations and select one recipient each month. A 911 Collision Centers representative will physically inspect vehicles to assess and estimate extent of damage and the repair work required and if the vehicle can be repaired under the program.

**RESCUE MY RIDE  
OFFICIAL PROGRAM RULES**

**1. Description.** This program is sponsored by 911 Collision Centers, begins August 2010 and ends at the discretion of 911 Collision Centers. Each person submitting a nomination accepts and agrees to be bound by these program rules. Each recipient must sign a liability release form before the vehicle is repaired.

**2. Eligibility.** No purchase necessary to nominate, enter or win. Recipients may be individuals or nonprofit organizations. Individual recipients must be a legal U.S. resident who is 21 years of age or older. Employees (and family members living under the same roof) of 911 Collision Centers are not eligible to be nominated or be a recipient of this program in his/her individual capacity. Eligible organizations must be tax-exempt, nonprofit status 501(3)c status.

Nominees will not be eligible if they are uninsurable for any of the following reasons:

- Prior DUI Conviction
- Reckless Driving Charge in the last 5 years
- Currently driving an uninsured vehicle

**3. How to Nominate.** Log on to [www.911collision.com](http://www.911collision.com) and complete the online nomination form. Individuals can also make a nomination by obtaining a nomination form at any 911 Collision Centers location and mailing or delivering the nomination form to 911 Collision Centers, 140 S. Euclid, Tucson, AZ 85719. All nominations become the property of 911 Collision Centers which has the right to use any information submitted.

Nominations must be filled out completely and legibly in order to qualify, and will be void if they are, in whole or in part, incomplete, illegible, damaged or fraudulent. 911 Collision Centers is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, misdirected or mutilated nominations, including due to transmission, technical, and/or network failures of any kind, including, without limitation, malfunctioning of any hardware or software (whether originating with sender or 911 Collision Centers) telephonic failures, human error, or any other error or malfunction.

Nominations selected by 911 Collision Centers and its selection committee, to be considered for the monthly program will be contacted by 911 Collision Centers in order to receive their authorization to release personal information on the 911 Collision Centers website. If this authorization is not obtained, the nomination will be withdrawn from the program. 911 Collision Centers will also require a copy of the nominee's valid driver's license, registration, and insurance card to verify they are insurable and the vehicle owner. 911 Collision Centers is not responsible for the use of such person's personally identifiable information by the person nominating them.

**4. Selection.** Each month, a selection committee will review nominations. A representative of 911 Collision Centers will physically inspect vehicle to assess and estimate auto body repair work required. All nominations remain eligible for consideration as long as the program continues and the vehicle and its owners continue to meet eligibility rules.

**5. Conditions of Acceptance.** Driver's license or other appropriate picture identification is required to claim the chosen vehicle. The adequacy of such proof is within the discretion of 911 Collision Centers. The individual or organization will be required to execute and return a release

and affidavit of eligibility on behalf of themselves within 7 days of selection to receive auto body repair work.

Each person submitting a nomination and each recipient agrees to the use of his/her/its name and likeness in publicity without any additional compensation, except where prohibited by law. Each person submitting a nomination and each recipient acknowledges 911 Collision Centers, have the right to publicize and broadcast their names, voices, and likenesses, the fact that the individual or family won, and all matters incidental thereto.

**6. Limitation on Liability.** Each recipient agrees to sign a Liability Release Form which forever discharges and releases 911 Collision Centers, subsidiaries, affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, employees, and agents from any and all liability, claims, causes of action, suits, and demands of any kind arising from or in connection with this program.

**7. Sponsor's Reservation of Rights.** These program rules are subject to modification by 911 Collision Centers in the event of a dispute, all decisions made by 911 Collision Centers Auto Family are final and binding. 911 Collision Centers reserves the right, in its/their sole discretion, to disqualify any person who tampers with the nomination process or the operation of 911 Collision Centers' website, or who otherwise acts in violation of these program rules. 911 Collision Centers further reserves the right, in its/their sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, or modify this program if, for any reason, the program is not capable of completion as planned (including, but not limited to, for the following reasons: infection by computer virus, technical corruption, force majeure, or non-authorized human intervention that compromises or affects the administration, fairness, integrity, security, or proper conduct of the program).
